












It's a great game, but we need more than one card to play







Contents (this is not a game)

All cards are 17 numbered 17



The number of cards equals the value Total cards = 45







2 Flow.....of the Game

Take cards from the middle of the table and replace with higher cards



This is repeated by each player in clockwise order as they are able and willing.

If you can't or don't want to exchange, you may pass

If everyone else passes, your card on the table will score. Yippee!

When someone empties their hand, the game is over. The player with the highest score wins!

🍕 4 Oh! --- Prapare for the game. Don't panic! 🥻

Return unused cards to the box according to player count

Shuffle the cards you need. Shuffle again. Once more. Okay!

Each player is dealt one card at a time until all cards are dealt

When a card is dealt, you should check the number

The player with the "1" card places it in the middle of the table

The first round of the game begins with you! Please, go ahead!

🎙 🚯 Start of the Round 🍃

A round continues until someone scores. Round repeat until the game is over.

The game starts with the player who plays the "1" card. Then on it is the player who scored the last round.

There will be no card at the beginning of the round. The winning player sets out 1 favorite card from their hand to start 場札はみんなで the next round.

Play continues clockwise from there.

Note, you cannot pass on the first turn of a round. No forgiveness. You also cannot play 2 or more cards.



6 What can you do on your turn?

In this game, the smaller the number, the stronger the card

R is the weakest.

It is **not** a wildcard.











On your turn, take a card (or cards) from your hand to exchange with those on the table, or pass.



When using multiple cards, use only the same value. Cards can be issued in two ways.



or




In method B, you can play regardless of the strength of the card. It can be stronger, weaker or same strength.



You cannot play two more cards than what is on the table.

In either case, the cards that were on the table come into your hand. It's an exchange, remember? The card(s) you played become the new table cards



The same number of cards can be exchanged for a stronger card










Or you can replace the one card with two equal cards, but only with 1 more card



Oops!
That's more than 1 more than what's on the table



When you cannot or don't want to play a card, you may pass.

Once you pass, you cannot join until next round

If you pass, put your hand on the tbale to show
you are out of the round.

It's polite.

Don't worry, you can come back in for the following round.



End of the Round



If all other players pass, the round is over.
At this time, place the cards from the middle
of the table to your side face up.
(This helps everyone see which cards
and how many are out of the game)



Don't add it to your hand by mistake!

Next round begins with the player who just scored.





End.....of the game

If it begins, it must also end.

It is the final round if someone plays their last cards.

The cards gained in this exchange

are placed face down in front of the player

(There is no opportunity to use it as a hand)

This makes it easy to see who went out first as the round continues.

And, of course, the game is over after this round.

9 Scoring (you want points)

Number cards are 1 pt. R cards are 0 pt.

The number on the card does not matter

However, the player who emptied their hand first gets to count each R card as 1 pt!!

Cards in hand and face down have no score.

The player with most points wins!



Make a note of your scores. Play a total of 3 games.
